"It's a great day to be a Saint!"

The headmaster at St. Andrew's Episcopal School while I served there as chaplain said this almost every day. We were the St. Andrew's Saints, and he was proud of and grateful for the staff, faculty, and students, always noticing when there was something good happening on campus, from art to academics to outreach to athletics to simple acts of kindness. Rain or shine, exam week or spring break, preschooler or graduating senior, it was always a great day to be a Saint—there was always something to celebrate, to be grateful for, to aspire to, to strive for. The highest grade or the game ball or the lead role might not always be yours, but you knew you were part of a community of people in which effort was appreciated and help was available and everyone's uniqueness was part of beautiful whole.

We sing a song of the saints of God every year on or around November 1—it's a great day to be a saint, although many whose names fill our scriptures and church history books might not have felt that way in their own day. We see them depicted in stained glass or brightly colored icons, surrounded by golden halos and other symbols of their sainthood. Each and every one of them, though—even our own Saints Stephen and John—were ordinary people, like us, doing their best to stay faithful in a world in which that isn't always easy.

On All Saints Day, while we remember the work and witness of these men and women, it isn't just the stained glass saints we celebrate. We celebrate the wonder that we are in community with everyone who has ever said "yes" to faith, whether that "yes" was whispered or shouted or sung. We don't live this life alone—we live it together, those who have gone before us, those who surround us now, those who will follow us, and all of us with God's help.

I hope you can join us for worship on Sunday, November 5—11:00 am at St. Stephen's, and 5:00 pm at St. John's—to remember and celebrate our own faithful departed, to say "yes" once again to our shared baptismal call to "proclaim by word and example the good news of God in Christ". It's a great day—every day is a great day—to be a saint!



Bishop Search Update

On Wednesday, November 1, a slate of 3-5 finalists to become the 11th Bishop of the Diocese of Mississippi will be announced. We are deeply grateful to the Search Committee for their prayerful and diligent work of discernment!

A petition period will follow, November 2-8, by which clergy who did not go through the search process may be nominated. Candidates brought forward by petition will undergo the same rigorous application process and background check. Forms for submitting names by petition can be found on the Bishop Search website.

The Transition Committee has planned a series of Meet and Greets to be held January 15-20, 2024, around the Diocese. People are welcome to attend any of these events; the event nearest us will be held the evening of January 17 at St. James, Greenville. Questions for the candidates to discuss at these gatherings will be submitted in advance - a form will be available for that on the Bishop Search website as well.

Let us continue to hold candidates, our working committees, and our Diocese in prayer as we move toward electing our new bishop!
